He obtained his board certification in internal medicine in 2011 and, in the same year, joined the staff of Pacific Hospitalist Associates, where he practiced as a hospitalist at Hoag Hospital in Irvine.

In 2012, Dr. Chris Liu then accepted the position of hospitalist at Kaiser Permanente Medical Center in Vallejo, California to return home to the Bay Area. He became a partner in 2015 and has assumed multiple roles as a hospitalist, from strict inpatient care on the medical floor, to attending to post stroke patients at the Kaiser Foundation Rehabilitation Center, and to teaching and instructing family practice residents on their inpatient rotations.
