An experienced sociologist, *Judy C. Morelock, PhD*, obtained her undergraduate degree and master's degree with honors from The University of Tennessee (UT). Around the time she commenced her doctoral studies, she began her longstanding career as a political activist, marching with black students who were advocating for a campus black studies program and founding the pioneering women's rights organization The Feminist Coalition. Dr. Judy C. Morelock earned her PhD in sociology with a 4.0 grade point average from The Pennsylvania State University.

Over the course of her career as an educator, *Dr. Judy C. Morelock* served 34 years as a lecturer at UT and 16 years as a professor with the historically black Knoxville College. Her work at the latter institution earned her accolades from several student organizations. She has also received a Meritorious Service Award from the NAACP and an Outstanding Law Enforcement Award from the Tennessee Department of Correction.
