A professor of pathology and neurosurgery at New York University (NYU), Dr. David Zagzag is also the chief of the Neuropathology Division at NYU Langone Medical Center. In addition, he is also the director of the Microvascular and Molecular Neuro-Oncology Laboratory. Highly recognized in the field of oncology, Dr. David Zagzag has been awarded the Lucien J. Rubenstein Award for Best Paper in Neuro-Oncology, the Award for Excellence in Clinical Science from the Society for Neuro-Oncology, and the Pioneer Award from the Children's Brain Tumor Foundation.

He currently works as a faculty member in the divisions of pathology and neurosurgery at Tisch Hospital and Bellevue Hospital Center, and was a consultant at the Veterans Administration Hospital. Dr. Zagzag joined NYU where he rose through the ranks to his current position. Licensed to practice in New York, he is double-certified by the American Board of Pathology in Anatomic Pathology and Neuropathology.

Maintaining a key interest in neuro-oncology vasculogenesis and angiogenesis, Dr. David Zagzag is a member of the World Health Organization International Agency for Research on Cancer and the American Cancer Society.
